The footfall counter at Kings Parade was upgraded on 19th March 2021 .Benchmark calculations (Year on Year and Week on Week) have been calculated using like for like data sets (only those counters available in both comparison periods) to ensure statistical accuracy

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 42,507,928 which is 79.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 14,264,381 which is 98% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 2 May 2022 was 952,544.


The busiest day in week commencing 2 May 2022 was Saturday with 190,088 visitors.

Footfall by week






Footfall by day




Footfall by hour




Footfall by week


