The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 54,093,680 which is 11.6% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 25,948,148 which is 9.2% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 19 June 2023 was 1,252,644.


The busiest day in week commencing 19 June 2023 was Saturday with 231,735 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 24 June 2023 with footfall of 23,184.


Footfall by week










Footfall by hour


