The footfall counter at Kings Parade was upgraded on 19th March 2021 .Benchmark calculations (Year on Year and Week on Week) have been calculated using like for like data sets (only those counters available in both comparison periods) to ensure statistical accuracy


The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 29,830,785 which is 11.8% down on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 9 August 2021 was 875,614.


The busiest day in week commencing 9 August 2021 was Saturday with 171,126 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 14 August 2021 with footfall of 18,431.




Footfall by day




Footfall by hour




Footfall by week


