The footfall counter at Kings Parade was upgraded on 19th March 2021 .Benchmark calculations (Year on Year and Week on Week) have been calculated using like for like data sets (only those counters available in both comparison periods) to ensure statistical accuracy

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 45,303,114 which is 51.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 28,589,757 which is 52.6% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 8 August 2022 was 930,180.


The busiest day in week commencing 8 August 2022 was Saturday with 166,465 visitors.






# Footfall by day




## Footfall by hour




