The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 54,629,052 which is 8.7% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 35,377,313 which is 8.4% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 14 August 2023 was 1,129,998.


The busiest day in week commencing 14 August 2023 was Saturday with 211,064 visitors.









#### Footfall Counts by day

## 2019 comparison for Cambridge BID


