The footfall counter at Kings Parade was upgraded on 19th March 2021 .Benchmark calculations (Year on Year and Week on Week) have been calculated using like for like data sets (only those counters available in both comparison periods) to ensure statistical accuracy

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 26,484,821 which is 25.1% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 11 October 2021 was 961,379.










#### Footfall by location


