The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID for the last 52 weeks is 56,132,092 which is 5.3% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 54,540,900 which is 5% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Cambridge BID in week commencing 11 December 2023 was 926,866.


The busiest day in week commencing 11 December 2023 was Saturday with 193,667 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 16 December 2023 with footfall of 23,033.


Footfall Counts by week










Footfall Counts by hour


